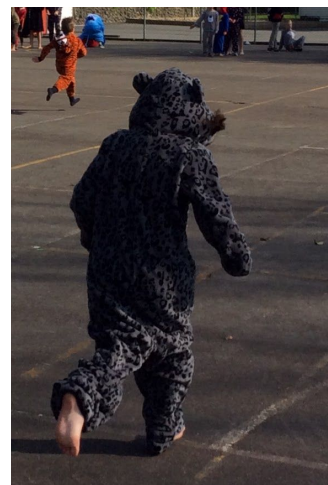
Thursday 27th September is Whānau sharing morning so watch out for more information.
