Re: Board Elections

2019 is an election year for school trustees. Tinui School will be holding its election on Friday 7 June. There are two parent representative vacancies. NZSTA (New Zealand Schools Trustees Association) has been working on ways to encourage more parents to stand for election. We understand that asking people to put their hand up and stand for election is difficult, especially if parents aren't clear on what the role entails.

A new programme is being offered called KORARI, this is designed to help encourage potential new trustees to come and find out what it really means to serve on a school board.

Rebekah Wright is facilitating a hui on Tuesday 2 April, 6pm @ Kuranui College. The hui will incorporate what being on a school board involves, what help is available, how school boards work and will be an opportunity to answer questions from attendees. You are welcome to talk with a current board member or attend a meeting to gain an understanding of what is involved.


