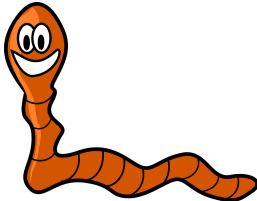

school because of miscommunication.

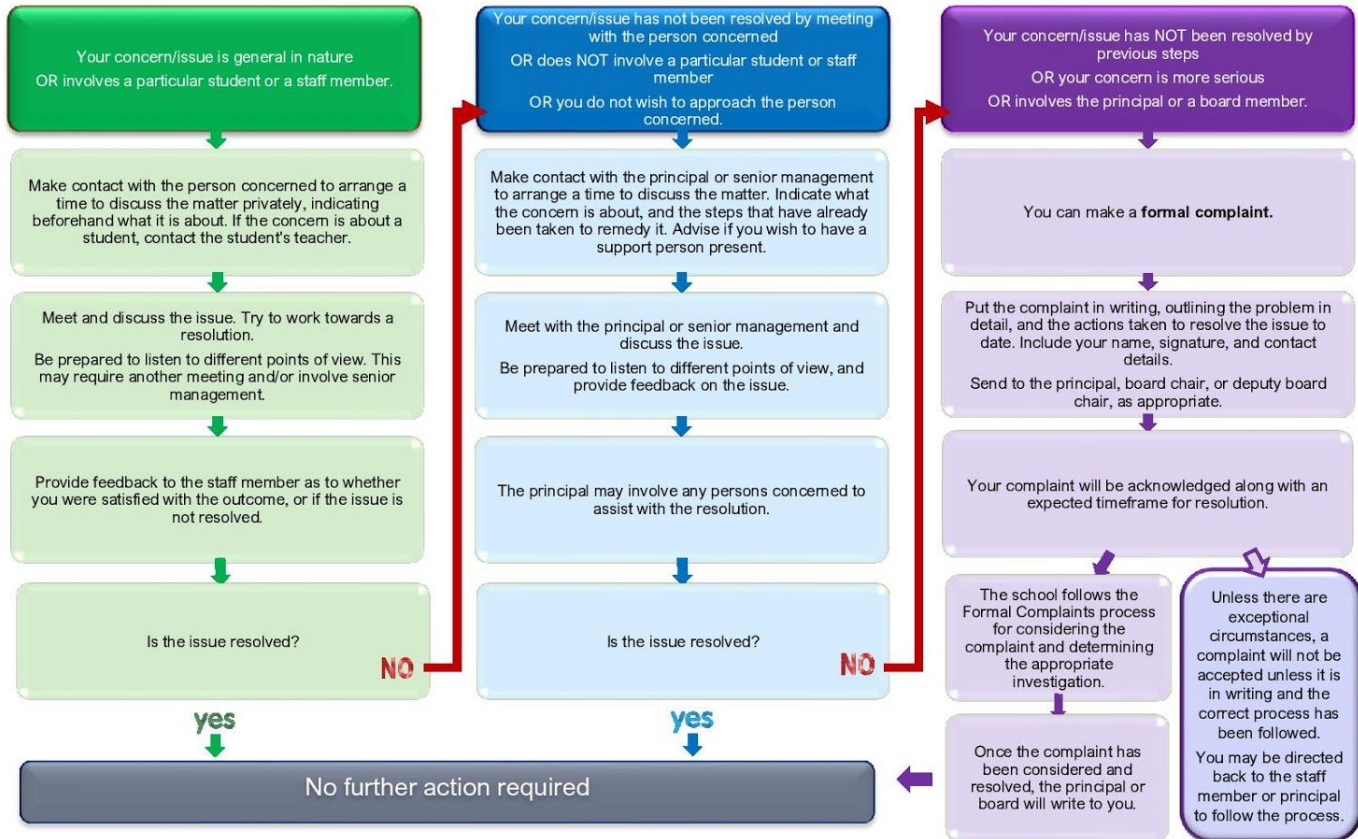
RUGBY AT BREAK TIMES
