More exciting news is our refurbishment of Room 2 transforming it into a maker space. This looks likely to start late October which will enable us to restructure where the senior students learn next year.

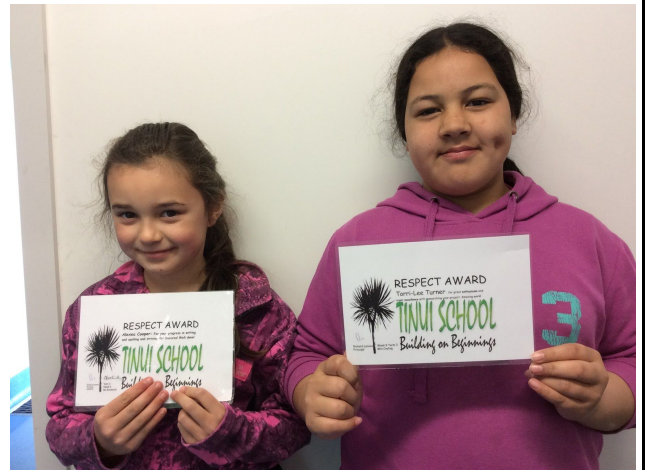
